

Summer School Admission Agreement

The Creek Preschool & Kindergarten has established these guidelines for your convenience and in an effort to alleviate confusion as to payments and regulations during the Summer School term.

Hours: Summer School runs on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9am-1pm only.

Attendance Requirements: School is open to students who are 2.0 years of age at camp start through 6 years of age. Your child does not have to be potty trained to attend; please pack your child's diapers or pull ups and wipes for the day in their pack.

Registration: No registration fee is due for summer school.

Fees: Summer School Payments are due on the first day of the week you attend, to cover your planned attendance in that week. We accept cash, checks, or EFT payments. There is a \$20 charge for returned checks or EFT payments.

Attendance: If you have signed up to attend on a day and have not arrived by 9:15am that morning without pre-payment for the day or letting us know that you are having a late start day, we reserve the right to give your child's spot away to a walk in student.

Cancellation of Scheduled Days: If you have signed up to come and no longer need care on those days please let us know so that we can take you off the list and allow someone from the waiting list to attend.

Walk-Ins: Walk-Ins for Summer School will only be accepted on a space available basis. If we are at capacity, we cannot take in additional children while maintain ratio standards. We recommend scheduling your summer school days in advance. Thank you for understanding.

Discounts: There are no discounts for summer school tuition.

The Creek Preschool reserves the right to cancel this Admission Agreement for any reason at any time.

The department of Licensing shall have the authority to interview children or staff, and to inspect and audit child or facility records without prior permission. The Department of Licensing shall also have the authority to observe the physical condition of a child, including conditions which could indicate child abuse, neglect, or inappropriate placement, and to have a licensed medical professional physically examine the child.

As a condition to enrollment of my child, I consent to and will comply with this admission agreement together with the policies and procedures outlined in the parent handbook.
